## Why can't my battery be fully charged after a period of time?

Did you activate the battery in the correct way? Please charge and discharge at least 3 times.

- 1. It can be solved by deep charge and discharge.
- 2. 2. Set the battery charging threshold: it can be set to 80% when charging starts and 100% when charging stops.
- 3. 3. Sometimes the battery cannot be fully charged, because the laptop battery is a lithium battery, it is easy to overcharge during the charging process, which will damage the battery or shorten the battery life. Therefore, manufacturers will protect laptop batteries from overcharge damage. The charging of the notebook computer can only be charged to less than 100%, which can protect the battery and extend the battery life.
- 4. 4. You can try to turn it off and charge it for 4 hours and then check whether the battery is fully charged; if it can be charged after shutdown, there may be a problem with the system or other settings. You can consider restoring the system and then try to run.
- 5. 5. Check whether the battery charging port is fixed.
